Race Format

Winter Nationals 400 has its own special format.

Heat Races

- Random draw for heat races
- Heat races are 30 laps in length for all classes but Novice they will run 20
- Depending on number of cars will depend on how many heat races per class.
- If there are 12 cars, then we will split the field into two races.
- There will be 2 sets of heat races.
- Top 3 average finishers in each heat race will make it to the A main.

- The rest of the cars will run in the B Main with the B main running before the A main.

Main Events

- Main events will have 6 cars qualifying in from their top 3 average finish in the heat races. The last two spots will be filled by the top 2 coming out of the B-Main.
- The lowest main event will run first
- Laps for main events are as follows:
 - A-Main – 50 Laps
 - B-Main – 30 Laps
 - C-Main – 20 Laps
 - D-Main and Lower – 20 Laps
 - Top Finisher from each main event will bump to the back of the next higher main event. Top 2 from the B-Main will make it into the A-Main.

Awards

Weekly

- Each racer will receive a plaque for each class they run in with the race dates on them. Each race date you will receive a sticker with your place to put on the plaque for the entire season. The end of the year the top 2 per class will receive a points series trophy.



- Series winners will win a trophy, new body and a new set of tires. Runner-up winners will win a new set of tires.
